## **MODEL OF HMS HOOD** ARRIVES SAFELY IN SCOTLAND

**Dutch-based moving** company Mondial Vogel Removals has recently moved a model of the battlecruiser HMS Hood from Holland to a new home in Glasgow, Scotland.

he scale model of the warship was part of an exhibition at the Polderhuis Museum in Middleburg, Holland where it had been displayed for the past ten years. However, the ship had to be moved to make room for another exhibition.

As the model is almost three metres long, it could not be moved using the elevator and had to be carried via the stairs: a great challenge for the movers.

The model ship is now on show at the Hood Association not far from where the original 262metre-long ship was built by John Brown & Company between 1916 and 1918.

The Hood was sunk by the German battleship Bismarck during the battle of Denmark Strait in May 1941. Of the 1,419 men on board, only three survived.

## Airbnb enters the relocation market

irbnb has expanded its Airbnb for Work service to focus directly on individuals relocating for work. In a recent press release the company said that 700,000 companies have so far had employees book with Airbnb for Work.

The company said that around 20% of employees worldwide are eager to relocate yet around 40% of international assignments are considered to be failures, with cultural adjustment being a key factor. Airbnb provides a temporary home for people that allows them to try out their new location in comfort and settle in more easily to their new surroundings.

Airbnb is also providing accommodation for off-site meetings and team-building events.
